- Awards and recognitions given by the chapter
- Attendance at inter-chapter events (i.e. sectional and regional conferences, and National Conventions)
- Participation in leadership and membership development programs

Presentations may be written, verbal, or visual. Materials may be presented in electronic format (VHS videotape, CD-ROM, or DVD-ROM, all limited to 15 minutes). However, you are responsible with providing the appropriate devices to present your submission (VHS player, CD-ROM drive, DVD player, etc.),

**Deadline for Submission**
